Sub: Grant of 1st and 2nd financial upgradations to EA/SEA/AE of AIR & Doordarshan under the ACP scheme of 9th August, 1999 consequent upon courts' direction. –Regarding.

Sir,

The Assured Career Progression Scheme for the Central Government civilian employees was notified by GOI, Department of Personnel & Training (DOP&T) vide OM No. 35034/1/1997-Estt.(D), dated 09.08.1999. The benefits of the scheme was however denied to the subordinate engineering employees of AIR & Doordarshan in spite of persuasions from individuals and staff Associations. The deprivation of legitimate benefits of the ACP Scheme lead few of the engineering employees of AIR/ Doordarshan, Patna filing OA No. 514 of 2002 in the Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench, Patna to seek legal justice in the matter.

Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench, allowed the OA and passed Order dated 7th September, 2009, directing the Government to grant the applicants EA/SEA/AE the 1st ACP in the Pay Scale of Rs 8000-275-13500 along with the consequential benefits, as and when they have completed 12 years of qualifying service in accordance with the ACP Scheme.

Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench's Judgment dated 7th September, 2009 has now been duly upheld by Hon'ble High Court, Patna through speaking Order dated 25th August, 2010 in CWJC No.6451 of 2010, filed by the UOI & Others against the Judgment dated

7th September, 2009 of the Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench. Copies of both the said judgments dated 07.09.2009 and dated 25.08.2010 are enclosed herewith as Annexure-I and Annexure-II respectively.

It is therefore requested to kindly issue orders granting 1st and thereafter 2nd financial upgradations in the Pay Scales of **Rs 8000-275-13500** and **Rs 10000-325-15200** respectively under the **ACP scheme of 9th August, 1999** to the eligible Engineering Assistants, Sr. Engineering Assistants and Assistant Engineers of AIR & Doordarshan, at the earliest, in compliance of the courts' order.
