सा.का.नि. 1(अ).—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परंतुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए भारतीय प्रसारण (इंजीनियर) सेवा नियम, 1981 का और संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात् :-

1.(1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम भारतीय प्रसारण (इंजीनियर) सेवा (संशोधन) नियम, 2013 है।

(2) इन नियमों में अन्यथा उपबंधित के सिवाय ये उनके राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. भारतीय प्रसारण (इंजीनियर) सेवा नियम, 1981 में, —

(क) नियम 4 में, "वेतन मान" शब्दों के स्थान पर "वेतन बैंड, ग्रेड वेतन, या वेतन मान" शब्द रखे जाएंगे।

(ख) नियम 10 के पश्चात् निम्नलिखित नियम अंतःस्थापित किया जाएगा और इसे 1 जनवरी, 2006 से अंतःस्थापित किया गया समझा जाएगा, अर्थात् :-

" 10क (1) वेतन बैंड 3 या वेतन बैंड 4 या उच्चतर प्रशासनिक ग्रेड में विनिर्दिष्ट ग्रेड वेतन वाले किसी विशिष्ट ग्रेड में किसी भारतीय प्रशासनिक सेवा के राज्य या संयुक्त संवर्ग के अधिकारी की केन्द्रीय सरकार में तैनाती की जाती है तो, भारतीय प्रसारण (इंजीनियर) सेवा के बैंचों से संबंध रखने वाले अधिकारियों, जो दो या अधिक वर्षों से ज्येष्ठ हैं और जिनकी उस विशिष्ट ग्रेड में अब तक प्रोन्नति नहीं हुई है, को भारतीय प्रशासनिक सेवा के अधिकारियों की केन्द्रीय सरकार में तैनाती की तारीख से अकृत्यकारी आधार पर अनुसूची-V में वर्णित विभागीय छानवीन (स्क्रीनिंग) समिति की सिफारिश पर समान ग्रेड प्रदान किया जाएगा।

(2) प्रोन्नति के लिए पात्रता और किसी विशिष्ट ग्रेड या वेतनमान में बैचमार्क से संबंधित उपबंधों को उस ग्रेड या वेतनमान में उच्चतर वेतन मान प्रदान करने के लिए छानवीन के समग्र कार्मिक और प्रशिक्षण विभाग के कार्यालय ज्ञापन संख्या एबी.14017/64/2008-स्था(आस्था) तारीख 24 अप्रैल, 2009 के अनुसार पूरा किया जाएगा।

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. 1(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service Rules, 1981, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service Amendment Rules, 2013.
(2) Save as otherwise provided in these rules they shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service Rules, 1981, —

(a) In rule 4, for the words “scales of pay” the words “pay band, grade pay or pay scale” shall be substituted.

(b) after rule 10, the following rule shall be inserted and shall be deemed to have been inserted, with effect from 1st day of January, 2006, namely:-

“10 A (1) Whenever an Indian Administrative Service Officer of the State or Joint Cadre is posted in Central Government to a particular grade carrying a specific grade pay in Pay Band 3 or Pay Band 4 or Higher Administrative Grade, the officers belonging to the batches of Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service who are senior by two years or more and have not so far been promoted to that particular grade shall be granted the same grade on non-functional basis from the date of posting of the Indian Administrative Service officers in that particular grade in Central Government on the recommendation of the Departmental Screening Committee mentioned in Schedule -V.

(2) The provisions relating to eligibility for promotion and ‘benchmark’ to a particular grade or pay scale shall be fulfilled at the time of screening for grant of higher pay scale in that grade or pay scale in accordance with the Office Memorandum No. AB.14017/64/2008-Estt.(RR), dated the 24th April 2009 of Department of Personnel and Training.

(3) The other terms and conditions for grant of higher pay scale on Non-Functional basis shall be in accordance with the orders and instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time.”

(c) for the words and brackets “Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional)” wherever they occur, the words and brackets “Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional Second Grade)” shall be substituted.

(d) for Schedule-I, following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:-

Note 1 The number of sanctioned posts includes temporary installation posts and is subject to variation depending on workload.

Note 2. Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional Second Grade) is non-functional grade and the maximum number of posts in this grade shall be equal to thirty percent of the senior duty posts consisting of all duty posts at the level of Senior Time Scale and above in the Cadre. The number of posts to be operated in the Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional Second Grade) will be further limited to the number of posts available in Senior Time Scale."

(e) in Schedule-III —

- (i) for the brackets, words, letters and figures "(See clause (C) of sub-rule (2), and (3) of rule 7)" the brackets, words, letters and figures "[See clauses (a) and (b) of sub-rule(2) of rule 7 and sub-rule (3) of rule 7]" shall be substituted;
- (ii) for the existing entries in column (4), relating to the posts against serial number 1, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"Officers in the Senior Administrative Grade in pay band-4, Rs. 37400-67000 with grade pay Rs. 10,000 with three years regular service in the grade ; or Officers with 25 years' of regular service in Group 'A' posts in the service out of which at least one year regular service should be in the Senior Administrative Grade."

- (iii) for the existing entries in column (4), relating to the posts against serial number 2, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"Officers in the Junior Administrative Grade in pay band-4, Rs.37400-67000 with grade pay Rs. 8700 with three years' regular service in the grade or Officers with 17 years regular service in Group 'A' posts in the service out of which at least one year regular service should be in the Junior Administrative Grade."

- (iv) for the existing entries in column (4), relating to the posts against serial number 3, the following entries shall be substituted and shall be deemed to have been substituted, with effect from 18th March, 2008, namely:-

"Officers in the Senior Time Scale in pay band-3, Rs.15600-39100 with grade pay Rs. 6600 with nine years' regular service in the grade including the service, if any, rendered in Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional Second Grade) in pay band-3, Rs.15600-39100 with grade pay Rs. 7600; or Officers who have completed 13 years of regular service in Group 'A' posts in the service out of which at least four years of regular service should be in the Senior Time Scale including the service, if any, rendered in Senior Time Scale (Non-Functional Second Grade)."

- (v) for the existing entries in column 4 relating to the posts against serial number 4, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"Officers in the Senior Time Scale in pay band-3, Rs. 15600-39,100 with grade pay Rs. 6600 with five years of regular service in the grade."

- (vi) for the existing entries in column 4, relating to the posts against serial number 5, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"Officers in Junior Time Scale in pay band-3, Rs.15600-39,100 with grade pay Rs. 5400 with four years of regular service in the grade."

- (vii) for the existing entries in column 4, relating to the posts against serial number 6, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

"Assistant Engineers of the All India Radio and Doordarshan excluding those in Civil Construction Wing in pay band-2, Rs.9300-34,800 with grade pay Rs. 4800 with two years' regular service in the grade"

- (viii) for the existing entry against the post at serial number 6, under column 3, for the entry "(i) 50 % by Promotion" the entry "(i) 50 % by promotion in accordance with clause (b) of sub-rule(2) of rule 7" shall be substituted;

(ix) the following Note shall be inserted, namely:-

"Note.- For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service, the service rendered by an officer prior to the 1st day of January, 2006, or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission."

(f) after Schedule-IV, the following Schedule shall be inserted and shall be deemed to have been inserted with effect from 1st day of January, 2006 namely :-

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM. — The Central Government has revised the terms and conditions of services of Government employees in compliance to the acceptance of the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations, with effect from the 1st day of January, 2006. Accordingly, to grant the Non-Functional Up-gradation to the members of Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service from the same date, in accordance with the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendations, Indian

Broadcasting (Engineers) Service Amendment Rules, 1981 have been amended with effect from 1st day of January, 2006. Similarly, provisions of column (4) of Schedule III against the post at serial number 3 has been amended in view of judgment dated the 11th February, 2010 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 1902 of 2010 and the same has been amended with effect from the 18th March, 2008, that is, the date of notification of the Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service Amendments Rules, 2008.

It is certified that no member of Indian Broadcasting (Engineers) Service is likely to be adversely affected by the notification being given retrospective effect.
